Cluck Privacy Policy

Cluck ("Cluck, "we" "us") respects the privacy of its users ("you") and has produced this Privacy Policy to inform you of how we will protect your privacy.

The Privacy Policy outlines the information we collect, how the information is used, with whom it may be shared and your options regarding data use and collection. We strongly suggest you read this Privacy Policy before creating an account and using the Service provided by Cluck.

1. Information we collect from you

- (ii) Data collected upon signup is dependent on the process used to register for the service.
- (iii) Consent given serves as our lawful basis for data processing.
- (iv) In order to create an account and use the Service provided by Cluck we will ask you to use an email address to register. The registration process allows us to determine the actual identity, and contact information, of specific persons. These sign up and login inputs are collected and stored by Cluck until the account is deleted or upon death, if Cluck is notified. While using the Service provided by Cluck, users will be encouraged to continue sharing data on an optional basis and provide additional data. Users will be free to share or not share any and all data other than the sign up and login information. We may also collect your geolocation information with your consent. This data and information may be collected through a website, mobile application or other online services. If you give us permission to access your contacts, we will use this data to provide suggestions for people you may know within the application and let you invite your contacts to use Cluck. By using the Service, you grant us permission to gather, parse and retain data related to the provision of the service unless you remove this additional data through the Service. When you release your data to Cluck through our Service, the information may be sent to servers located across the world.

2. Cookies and use of cookies

When you visit our Service, we may assign your device one or more cookies or other technologies that facilitate personalisation to facilitate access to our Service and to personalise your experience. Through the use of a cookie, we also may automatically collect information about your activity on our Service, such as the pages you visit, the time and date of your visits and the links you click. 3. How we use the information we collect

We may use information that we collect about you to:

- communicate with you by email, postal mail, telephone and/or mobile devices about products or services that may be of interest to you either from us or other third parties;

- website or mobile application analytics;
- verify your eligibility and deliver prizes in connection with contests and sweepstakes;
- enforce or exercise any rights in our Terms of Use;
- · obtain statistics on your ordering behaviour and
- perform functions or services as otherwise described to you at the time of collection.

4. Data retention.

We keep your information only as long as we need it for legitimate business purposes and as permitted by applicable legal requirements. You may clear all of your data at any time by requesting to do so under GDPR - primarily, but not limited to, 'the right to erasure.' You may withdraw consent for processing of data at any time. If you close your account, we may retain certain data for analytical purposes and record-keeping integrity, as well as to prevent fraud, enforce our Terms of Use, take actions we deem necessary to protect the integrity of our Service or our users, or take other actions otherwise permitted by law. In addition, if certain information has already been provided to third parties as described in this Privacy Policy, retention of that information will be subject to those third parties' policies.
